

Thank you for all of your assistance.

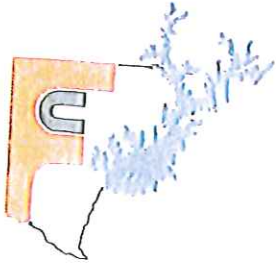

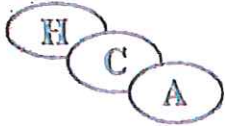
